What is Advent? Advent is season of the church year that commemorates Christ coming to earth as both God and human. The season recognizes the **prophetic** promises of the birth, the **humility** displayed by his birth, the heavenly **grandeur** of his nature and the future promise of second coming which we as Christians wait for. The Season of "coming" is celebrated by advent wreaths, candles and advent calendars. It is celebrated by congregations in worship services and by families in the home.
